



## MILLCREEK JOINS THE CELEBRATION

The Wasatch Front Regional Council, in partnership with the Utah Department of Transportation; Utah Transit Authority; Bike Utah; Jordan River Commission; Mountainland Association of Governments; Utah Department of Health; Utah Governor's Office of Outdoor Recreation; and Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, and Weber counties, is celebrating the completion of the Golden Spoke network. The Golden Spoke consists of over 100 miles of safe, separated, and connected multi-use trails, including [Ogden River Parkway](#), [Denver and Rio Grande Western Rail Trail](#) (funded gap), [Legacy Trail](#), [Jordan River Trail](#), [Murdock Canal Trail](#), and [Provo River Parkway](#), and links Ogden and Provo.

The celebration includes two simultaneous group bike rides on Saturday, June 2nd, one beginning in Ogden heading south and the other from Provo heading north converging at the Jordan River Bridge in Salt Lake City. There will be community events hosted along the way, as well as a final celebration at the Fisher Mansion in Salt Lake City, which will include guest speakers and family-friendly activities.

Millcreek wants to join in the celebration with our own group ride along the nearly completed Parleys Trail to meet up with the group from Provo at a point where the trails converge, and we invite everyone to be part of the festivities.

The Millcreek ride will start at the Grandeur Peak Trailhead located at Wasatch Boulevard and 2950 South at 11:30 AM and should meet the main group heading north along the Jordan River Parkway at around 12:30 PM. Please join Millcreek Mayor Jeff Silvestrini and other officials at the Grandeur Peak Trailhead at 11:00 AM for some mingling and refreshments before the ride.
